

Wyre Forest Young Voices Child Performers Policy

Wyre Forest Young Voices is committed to keeping our young people safe at all times, and especially while giving performances. This policy outlines the procedures which are followed to ensure that performances are safe for our members.

Photography/Videography

- Photographs/videos for marketing purposes will only be taken on the WFYV Phone by a member of WFYV staff. Any members whose parents have not given photo-consent will have their faces covered before any photos are shared via the WFYV social media.
- Parents/relatives of members must only photograph their own child, and should never share these photos on social media or with others via direct messaging/email. An announcement will be made at the start of every concert to remind families of this.
- Should unknown members of the public start to take photographs/videos, for example during concert-day rehearsals, they will be approached by a member of WFYV staff and asked to stop doing so, and to delete any photos/videos they have taken.

Safety of Members on Performance Days

- In alignment with our health & safety policy, members will be given sufficient opportunities to eat, drink and use the toilet on performance days.
- Should a member become unwell during a performance, they will be taken off-stage to an appropriate space by the First Aider to receive medical attention. If parents are in attendance, they will be asked to accompany the member and First Aider, otherwise another member of staff will accompany them.
- Members are to always stay with WFYV staff members on performance days, and never wander off. Staff will supervise to ensure that members are always kept safe and well, and are safeguarded from members of the public.
